At the end of the morning we will share a free lunch

We are seeking helpers who like to communicate confidently, and who are comfortable using a tape-measure, cutting materials and using basic tools, like screwdrivers. Some of the tasks could also involve climbing ladders. Otherwise no previous experience or skill is needed.

In return for your help, we are offering free refreshments AND in the afternoon (from 2.00 to 4.00 pm) there will be a free workshop to learn practical skills for making your own home or community building more energy efficient.
