Energy Champions Training @Vine URC, Ilford Saturday 7th May

More and more people are having difficulty paying their fuel bills, as the cost of heating homes rises. This will get worse as the price of energy increases.

Vine URC church and the Community Energy Group at Transition Town Ilford https://www.transitionilford.org/community-energy are keen to encourage residents to save energy in their homes and in public buildings as part of our commitment to creating a sustainable, zero carbon local community.

In order to move this goal forward we are joining forces to offer a free course for local people who want to become volunteer Community Energy Champions.

After the training participants will be asked to commit a small amount of time to run Energy Cafesat community and faith venues in Ilford.

Volunteers will be supported by an experienced adviser to give advice on:

- Saving energy and money by changing their fuel tariff or supplier
- Taking simple actions to make their home more energy efficient
- Becoming more aware of financial help, including debt reduction.

The course will be run by an experienced energy adviser, is free and will be a mix of in person and 4 online sessions.
