






Neighbourhood Education and Engagement Team



Financial & Environmental impact

UK householders throw away £12.5 billion worth of good food and drink every year

Redbridge is the 5th highest waste producing authority in the country.

A 1/3 of our bin bag is food waste





Sending food to landfill generates **methane:** one of the most harmful greenhouse gases, it contributes to global warming.

Reducing food waste can save you over £70 a month





Top tips to reduce food waste in Redbridge

Let's shop smart, eat well and save ££s

☑ □ UK households throw away £12.5 billion worth of good food and drink every year

Plan Ahead

- Check what's in your cupboard, fridge or freezer before going shopping, take a photo if it helps
- Plan meals
- Make a shopping list
- Only buy what you need and will use

Proper portions

- Only cook what you will eat, freeze or share
- Use handy measuring tools like cups, spoons and scales



2 Understand dates

- 'Use by' you shouldn't consume any food or drink past this date
- 'Best Before' defines quality not safety
- 'Sell by' and 'Display until' are guides for the shop, ignore these

5 Love Leftovers

- Freeze or share any of your leftover food
- Share recipes with your family and friends

3 Store food correctly

- Know what goes in your fridge, freezer or store cupboard
- Storing food properly can give your food lots of extra life
- The ideal fridge temperature is between 0-5°C
- You can freeze most foods such as bread, milk, meat, cooked food and even eggs!

6 Compost your scraps

- 1/3 of the waste we throw in the bin can be composted
- Shrink your bin bags, transform kitchen and garden waste into compost for your garden
