1.30pm Arrive at the Buddhist Vihara at 9 Balfour Road IG1 4HP (*Shoes to be removed if entering the prayer room*). Talk at 1.30pm



1.50pm Depart Vihara to continue Walk

2.10pm Arrive at the Hindu Temple, 43 Cleveland Road IG1 1EE (*Shoes to be removed when entering temple*). Talk at 2.15pm



2.30pm Depart Temple to continue Walk

2.35pm Arrive at Ilford Islamic Community Centre 52 - 56 Albert Road IG1 1HW
 Talk at 2.40pm. There will be an opportunity to visit the Mosque (where shoes need to be removed & women are required to cover heads.) There will also be a **talk from a representative of the Baha’i Faith at 2.50pm**
