**1.30pm Arrive at the Buddhist Vihara** at 9 Balfour Road IG1 4HP (*Shoes to be removed if entering the prayer room*). Talk at 1.30pm



**1.50pm Depart Vihara to continue Walk**

**2.10pm Arrive at the Hindu Temple**, 43 Cleveland Road IG1 1EE (*Shoes to be removed when entering temple*). Talk at 2.15pm



**2.30pm Depart Temple to continue Walk**

**2.35pm Arrive at Ilford Islamic Community Centre** 52 - 56 Albert Road IG1 1HW  
Talk at 2.40pm. There will be an opportunity to visit the Mosque (*where shoes need to be removed & women are required to cover heads.*)
